

WATER SUPPLIES

All mixer fittings are supplied with a flow straightener in the spout except the basin mixers B4447AA, B9208AA and kitchen mixer B4449AAA. When fitting on pressures in excess of 1.0 bar it is recommended than an aerator (not supplied) should be substituted. These are available from Ideal Standard stockists:

Bidet A960931AA Bath fittings A960309AA.

B4447AA, B9208AA and kitchen mixer B4449AAA have a 5 litre/min regulated aerator (B960754AA) with a flow straightener insert (A962713NU) supplied separately. When fitted on pressures below 1 bar it may be preferably to substitute the aerator with a flow straightener insert.


It is recommended that the hot and cold supply pressures are reasonably balanced and from a common source.

CONNECTIONS

The connections to the fittings are as follows:

WATER ECONOMY

The Sandringham SL single lever basin and bidet fittings incorporate a water saving mechanism known as the "CLICK" cartridge. Commonly users of single lever cartridges were found to raise the flow control lever fully causing an overuse of water. The "CLICK" mechanism was developed as a tactile guide to make it easy to open the valve to a gentle rate when a lesser flow is required.

WATER ECONOMY AND LIMIT STOP

As the lever is raised an obvious resistance is felt when it is about half way up. Raising the lever past this resistance permits the cartridge to be opened fully.

The mechanism consists of two parts. An outer ring and a shoe (see fig 2).

To remove, slide off shoe. The click ring can then be snapped off by placing a screwdriver under and prising upwards.




SETTING THE BLEND CONTROL

The Sandringham SL single lever basin and bidet fittings incorporate a blend control. This is a simple mechanical limit stop, located under the single lever handle, which restricts the angle to which the handle can be rotated towards the full hot position.

To set it, the hot water system should be operating and the hot water up to normal working temperature.

A thermometer will be required to measure the maximum blend temperature. (Refer to drawing on page 5)

- 1. Remove the handle (1) & shroud (4).
- 2. Remove the two-part 'CLICK' mechanism (6a) see opposite.
- 3. The blend ring, which is factory set in position '0' can then be prised up and rotated to the desired setting. There are 8 positions (0-7), the higher the number the lower the maximum blend temperature.
- 4. Push the blend ring back down to lock in its new position.
- Operate the fitting and rotate the handle as far as it will go to the left. Measure the water temperature and make further adjustments as necessary.
- 6. Refit 'click' mechanism, shroud and handle.

4 MAINTENANCE

The unique ceramic disc cartridge contains ultra smooth ceramic discs. They are so hard that they always remain sealed together, polishing one another in use, and sand, sediment and other waste borne matter cannot get between them or damage them. Even the hardest water has no effect and this means that the Sandringham SL fittings should give many years of efficient, trouble free service without the drip and liming up problems associated with traditional taps.

However, in the unlikely event of a failure, or any problem, simply exchange the cartridge. First check the outlet nozzle for possible blockage due to a build-up of debris from the pipework.

Basin and Bidet Fittings

- 1. Turn off both hot and cold water supplies.
- 2. Raise lever handle fully, remove plastic index cap (3) and undo grub screw (2).
- 3. Pull off shroud (4).
- 4. Remove click mechanism components (6a).
- 5. Undo screws (5). The cartridge can then be lifted out.
- 6. Ensure seals (7) have been removed with the cartridge.
- Position new cartridge ensuring the location peg engages in the appropriate hole and reverse the procedure for assembly.




Figure 6a B4447 & B9208 Sandringham single lever basin mixers




Figure 6b B4448 Sandringham single lever bidet mixer

CARTRIDGE REPLACEMENT

Bath Fittings

- 1. Turn off both hot and cold water supplies
- 2. Remove index buttons (3)
- 3. Undo grub screws (1) using an Allen key
- 4. Pull off handles (1)
- 5. Slacken screw (4) and pull off drive insert (5)
- 6. Unscrew cartridge (6) and replace with the new one
- Reverse the procedure for assembly




Figure 4 Bath fittings
